It is imperative that we have parent support throughout the season. There is a big time crunch at competitions, and we need many hands to make things go smoothly so our band can focus on their performance. Volunteering is an extremely rewarding experience. One that you will not regret.

Coming soon, the season Competition Help Sign Up Poll will be published that will include all of the football and competition dates. Each date will have slots for pit, prop and chaperone help. Sign up to volunteer for any of the slots. Each Sunday morning after a competition Saturday, all of the volunteer names from the previous day's competition along with volunteers from any football games since the previous drawing will be put into a hat. One name will be drawn and the winner will receive a \$50 credit on their student's band account. Each time you volunteer, your name goes in the next drawing.

Please note: that exact times volunteers will be needed for a given game or competition will not be known until we know our performance slot closer to the date. Historically, help is needed for football games from about 5:30-8:30 and competition help is needed roughly 2-11pm on competition dates. There may be tweaks in either direction so when signing up, it would be good to block off the whole evening on Football Fridays and afternoon/evening for competition Saturdays on the days you sign up.
